

Eden Valley Hospice Raffle – Annual Grand Draw 2009

Full Terms and Conditions:

1. These Terms and Conditions are the Raffle Rules. By entering the raffle, entrants agree to be bound by these rules.
2. This lottery is being promoted by and on behalf of Eden Valley Hospice.
3. For the purpose of the Gambling Act 2005, this raffle is defined as a 'Society Lottery.'
4. This lottery is licensed by the Gambling Commission.
5. To enter the raffle, you must be a UK resident aged 16 (sixteen) or over.
6. There will be one winner of the vehicle identified and no cash alternative will be offered although additional prizes could be offered.
7. All tickets shall be priced at £1.00
8. All raffle entry sales are final and no refunds shall be made at any time. All entrants acknowledge that their payment of £1.00 per ticket to enter the raffle does not guarantee that they will win any prize.
9. A maximum amount of £20 in tickets can be purchased by any one individual.
9. The draw for the prizes will be made at Tesco Store, Rosehill Carlisle to be held on 10 October 2009 You do not need to be present at the draw to win the raffle.
10. The winning entrant should produce their counterfoil of the ticket to claim their prize.
11. Eden Valley Hospice reserves the right in exceptional and unforeseen circumstances to substitute any prize acquired for the raffle for a similar prize at Eden Valley Hospice's absolute discretion.
12. Full payment for each ticket must be received either in the form of cash or cleared funds before the ticket can be entered into the draw. Only tickets for which full payment has been received either in the form of cash or cleared funds is eligible to win the prize.
13. The winners of the raffle prizes will be notified by letter or telephone.
14. All entrants are solely responsible for providing Eden Valley Hospice with their accurate and up-to-date contact details and Eden Valley Hospice will be in no way liable for any failure or inability to contact any entrant due to any errors, omissions or inaccuracies in the contact details that the entrant has provided. In the event that an entrant changes their contact details, they will be solely responsible for advising Eden Valley Hospice of the change.
15. By accepting the prize, the winner agrees to take part in promotional activity and Eden Valley Hospice reserves the right to use the name and address of the winner, their photograph and audio and/or visual recordings of them in any publicity unless prior notification has been received.
16. Each raffle number is unique. Any member may subsequently request an alternative raffle number if they wish at any time and this will be issued providing that it has not already been allocated to an existing entrant.
17. Eden Valley Hospice shall not be liable to the entrant for any loss or damage suffered or arising from:-
 - any delays or failures in the postal service or other delivery methods used by Eden Valley Hospice or the entrant.
 - any delays or failures in any software or other systems used by Eden Valley Hospice for the administration of the raffle.
 - any delays or failures in the Banking system used by Eden Valley Hospice or the entrant.
 - any failure to enter a chance into the draw.
 - any event beyond the reasonable control of Eden Valley Hospice
18. Nothing within these terms and conditions shall create or should be construed as creating any form of contract between any entrant and Eden Valley Hospice
19. Any complaints relating to the raffle should be sent in writing to the Fundraising Manager Eden Valley Hospice giving full details of the complaint and supporting documentation.
20. Eden Valley Hospice is committed to protecting the entrants privacy. Data that is collected from the entrant is used lawfully in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998 and is used solely for the purpose of processing raffle chances and informing winners that they have won a prize.
21. Any entrant has the right to access the information held about them. To obtain this information, please contact Eden Valley Hospice in writing.
22. Eden Valley Hospice will not sell, rent or grant access of any personal data to any third party without express prior permission.
23. In the event of any dispute regarding the rules, the decision of Eden Valley Hospice shall be final and no correspondence or discussion shall be entered into.
24. Eden Valley Hospice reserves the right to amend these rules at any time. If Eden Valley Hospice this, it will publish the amended rules.
25. Eden Valley Hospice reserves the right to disqualify any entrant if it has reasonable grounds to believe the entrant has breached any of these rules.
26. The Eden Valley Hospice member responsible for the promotion of the raffle is Eden Valley Hospice.
27. Each entrant should retain a copy of these Terms and Conditions for their reference.
28. This raffle is a form of gambling. Participants are encouraged to gamble sensibly.
